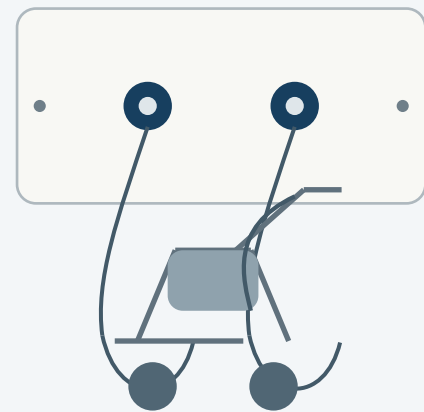

Buggy Locks for Prams & Pushchairs

A compact wall-mounted security system that gives parents and carers a designated point for securing unattended prams, pushchairs and folding buggies.

The supplied customer/order list records 11 order entries across 10 named project sites, representing 72 buggy-lock positions. The examples include leisure centres, councils, a children's centre and a hospital recreation facility, with both two-lock and four-lock configurations.

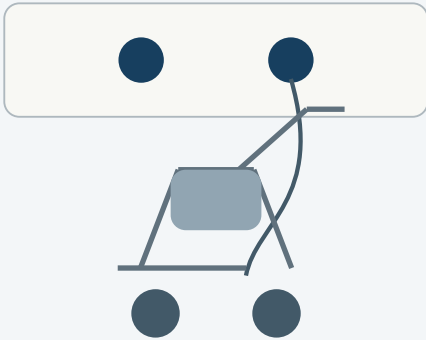
THE REQUIREMENT

Organised pram security without adding bulky floor-standing storage

Operational problem

Prams and pushchairs left unsecured in entrances, corridors or communal areas can create clutter and inconvenience. Family-friendly venues need a simple way to provide a designated security point while preserving circulation space.



Cable secures to a strong, fixed section of the buggy frame

Buggy lock approach

The compact laminate board fixes to a suitable wall. A user passes the security cable around a strong, fixed part of the buggy frame, operates the coin lock and retains the released key until returning.

CURRENT PRODUCT SPECIFICATION

System type	Wall-mounted coin-operated pram and pushchair locking system
Capacity	Two-lock system on one board or four-lock system on two boards
Board size	Approximately 600 mm wide x 145 mm high x 10 mm deep per board
Board material	Compact-grade laminate
Locking	Ojmar coin-operated user-key system; coin-return operation available subject to configuration
Staff access	Master-key access; standard four-lock system includes one master key and two user keys per lock
Location	Suitable for indoor and outdoor installation
Warranty / lead time	Two-year warranty; approximately 10 working days subject to availability

Wall position and circulation space matter

The installation should not obstruct fire exits, corridors, doors, ramps or accessible routes. The installer must select fixings suitable for the wall construction and position the system so parked buggies do not create a trip or access hazard.

Typical planning inputs

- Expected number of parked prams or pushchairs
- Available wall width and clear circulation space
- Indoor or outdoor installation
- Required coin denomination and return/retain operation
- Wall construction and suitable fixings
- Whether two or four locking positions are needed

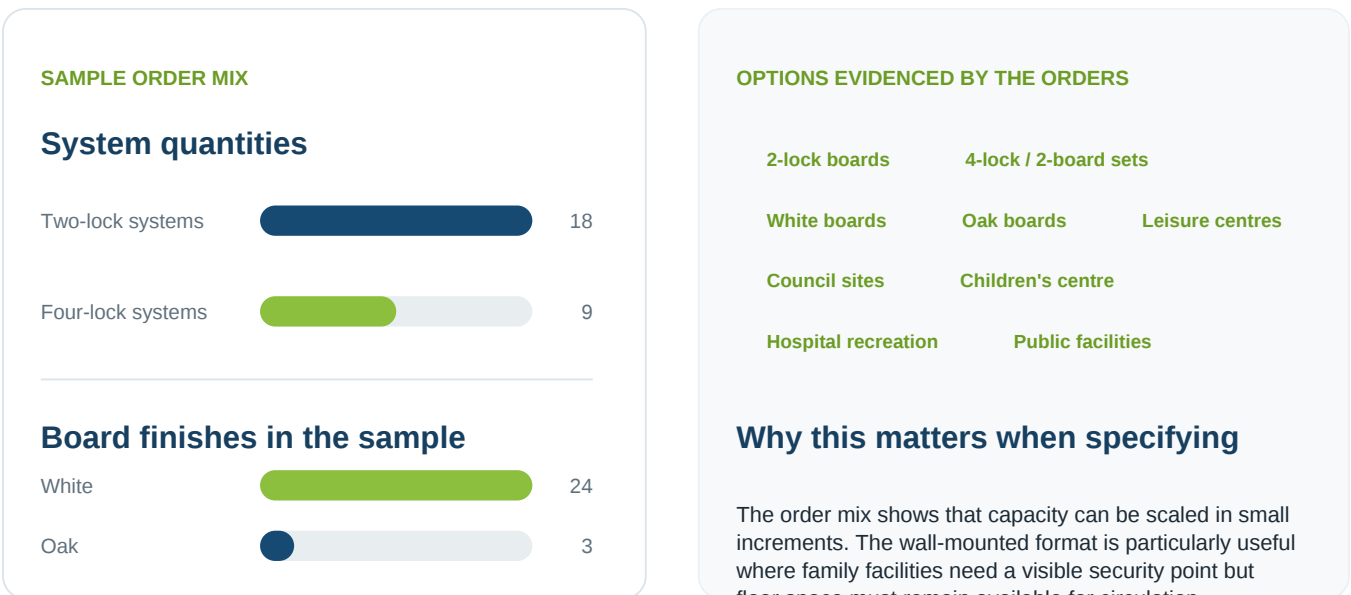
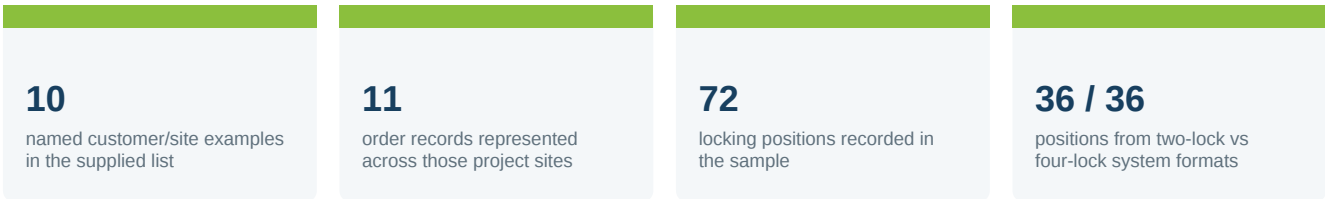
